

## **AFRICAN HONEYMOONS SPELL PAMPERED ADVENTURE**

The safari honeymoon features four days accommodations at the Twelve Apostles Hotel and Spa in Cape Town, three days at the famed Singita Private Game Reserve, one night in Johannesburg, and four days of island activities on the Seychelles.

Land Arrangements start at \$18,995 per person, with economy air fare beginning at \$2,695 round trip, including fuel charges, from New York to Cape Town, Johannesburg, and Mahe.

### **Diamond Level: Southern Luxuries and Wildlife Wonders: 15 days**

For honeymooners who love wildlife and the outdoors, this 15-day South African itinerary combines stays at three different game reserves with Cape Town and a final overnight in Johannesburg. The itinerary begins with four days in Cape Town at the Twelve Apostles Hotel and Spa, complete with 1 ½ days of private sightseeing with a car and driver, and a home-hosted dinner. Next, three days each are spent at Madikwe Reserve and Leopard Hills Safari Lodge at Sabi Sands Reserve – known for the greatest density of wildlife in southern Africa. Two nights are then devoted to a stay in Kings Camp at the Timbavati Reserve., with 36 different species of animals and 360 bird species. During game drives for sightings of the "Big Five, rangers make an effort to track the wildlife of most interest to the honeymoon party.

Land arrangements start at \$7,995 per person, double occupancy, and include all accommodations, wildlife viewing and other activities, most meals, and regional

charter flights within South Africa. Round trip air fare to South Africa is additional, and begins at \$1,525 per person New York – Cape Town – Johannesburg – New York.

**Royal Level: SOUTHERN EXPLORER: 12 days**

Honeymooners can trade Victoria Falls for Niagara Falls, combining two days at the legendary falls with three days each in Cape Town and Kruger National Park, plus an overnight in Johannesburg. Two full days touring Cape Town plus a dinner with a Capetonian family are followed by a stay at Lion Sands River Lodge luxury camp in Kruger National Park, including morning and afternoon wildlife drives. At Victoria Falls a walking tour and an evening sundowner cruise on the Zambezi provide various vistas of one of the world's highest falls. If your visit coincides with a full moon, the lunar rainbow (or moon bow) is truly something special to behold.

Land arrangements start at \$5,295 per person, and include accommodations, sightseeing, game drives, Zambezi river cruise, daily breakfast, plus select lunches and dinners.

Economy airfare begins at \$2,275 for New York – Cape Town – Victoria Falls – Johannesburg – Kruger Park – Johannesburg – New York.
