

FREE BUSINESS CLASS TICKET TO AFRICA

Extensive sightseeing at the Victoria Falls features a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River and a guided tour of the Falls from the Livingstone, Zambia side.

This safari combines luxury lodges with incredible wildlife viewing in three different game-rich ecosystems. Two nights are spent at each of Orient Express Safaris' Botswana camps: Khwai River Lodge in the Moremi Reserve, Savute Elephant Camp in the Chobe Park and Eagle Island Camp in the Okavango Delta. Travelers can continue their safari adventure through Namibia with the "Southern Jewels", to experience the ultimate African odyssey.
